# Anniversary of the Dedication October 25th/26th

The anniversary of a Church's dedication is celebrated with the rank of a solemnity. This will be marked by special readings for the occasion: Isaiah 56:1, 6-7, Ephesians 2:19-22 and Luke 19:1-10.

In the early stages of humanity's religious development, people thought of the whole world as sacred, but, as they came to realise that there were forces hostile to the sacred in the world, places and spaces were set apart where worship could take place and where those forces could be excluded. In the rite of dedication (celebrated here in 1988), the Church is made a sacred place as a symbol, and as the prayer indicates, because of what goes on within it. It is the place where the waters of Baptism overwhelm the shame of sin...God's people die to sin and live again through grace his adopted children. Here, "prayer, the Church's banquet," is made and continual prayer for the salvation of the world ascends to God.

The Church building is holy because of the praise of God's holy people in it.
