

**Readings for next weekend — Third Sunday of Advent**  
*First reading: Isaiah 35:1-6, 10; Second reading: James 5:7-10; Gospel: Matthew 11:2-11*

**Evangelisation and Catechesis**

Following on from last Sunday's homily, a total of 10 children across four Masses made their First Communion this year (out of a total of 90), where are the other 80? And out of 60 children who were Confirmed this year, only 11 were at our weekend Masses. This suggests that our sacramental programs are not producing fruit... we've put a lot of money, time and effort into these programs but for very little long-term gain. Time for a re-think. Evangelisation rather than catechesis needs to be our focus and for this reason we will be promoting ALPHA again next year as means for people to either meet Jesus Christ for the first time, or to have their relationship with him deepened and strengthened. Our future as a parish depends on this.

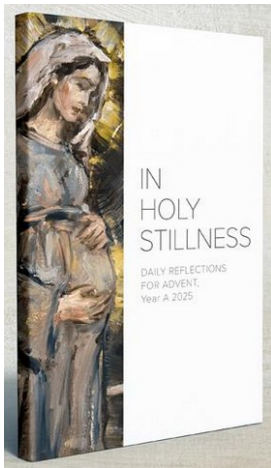

## 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday of Advent:

Both Isaiah and John the Baptist speak directly of God's Kingdom to come, though in very different language. This invites us into the frequent "both/and" nature of Catholic faith. In his letter to the Romans, St. Paul invites the community to hold on to hope in the fullness of the kingdom, and to live in its "harmony" in the present.

Given the broken and war-torn state of our world, it might be difficult to trust that the peace and justice of God will ever come to fruition. Violence and conflict seem to prevail and this can overwhelm us and make us feel useless in the face of evil. Today's readings invite us to trust above all in the kingship of Christ, who will bring peace and justice. The Christian faith is one of hope rather than despair, life rather than death, and light rather than darkness.
