1st reading: Ecclesiasticus 3:2-6,12-14; 2nd reading: Colossians 3:12-21; Gospel: Matthew 2:13-15,19-23

Excerpt #2 from the Parish Priest’s November Report:

To help us share the good news of Jesus with others we have conducted a very successful Alpha this year. Alpha is about developing a personal relationship with Jesus Christ. The next Alpha will run here beginning Monday **May 4th 2026**.

From a liturgical point of view our parish has experienced some great initiatives this past year. Very significant is the return of Holy Communion under both forms. The General Instruction on the Roman Missal #281 says: Holy Communion has a fuller form as a sign when it takes place under both kinds (bread and wine). For in this form the sign of the Eucharistic banquet is more clearly evident.

A new floor in the choir area has greatly improved the quality of the sound, especially when the orchestra is playing. We have also seen a big uptake in the number of parishioners offering themselves to take on a liturgical ministry. It’s important to remember that every liturgical ministry - reader, server, minister at the altar, extraordinary minister of communion, welcomer, choir/musician - is always about putting to use the gifts of the Holy Spirit for the building up of Christ’s body the Church (The third element of our parish vision).

Our ministry to children with special needs will see the live-streaming of the Sunday evening Mass on the last Sunday of the month into the meeting room so that these children and their families can participate in the liturgy in a way that is appropriate to their circumstances.
